Thank you for participating in this information session for Vancouver Airport Fuel Facilities Corporation's (VAFFC) Vancouver Airport Fuel Delivery Project.

ABOUT THIS INFORMATION SESSION: As the first stage of consultation, VAFFC is holding information sessions in February and March 2009 to provide an overview of the project. We want your input, your insights and your questions regarding the proposed new fuel delivery system for Vancouver International Airport (YVR).

Further public consultation sessions will be held later in the year to explain the proposed project in detail to the public, First Nations and other stakeholders prior to submitting an application to the BC Environmental Assessment Office for an Environmental Assessment Certificate.

ABOUT VANCOUVER AIRPORT FUEL FACILITIES CORPORATION: VAFFC is a not-for-profit company owned by a consortium of commercial airlines representing most of the domestic and international carriers serving YVR. VAFFC owns and operates fuel storage and distribution facilities at YVR. Similar fuel facility corporations operate at all of the major international airports across Canada.

ABOUT THE PROPOSED FUEL DELIVERY SYSTEM: VAFFC is proposing a new aviation fuel delivery system to YVR. The project consists of a marine terminal and fuel receiving facility at an existing industrial site on the south arm of the Fraser River, and an underground fuel pipeline connecting the facility and YVR.

The pipeline is expected to travel along existing transportation utility corridors in Richmond. The proposed 15-km pipeline corridor is preliminary and will be further refined. Several alignment options are under consideration and they will require input from the public, First Nations, stakeholders and regulatory bodies.

HOW WILL YOUR FEEDBACK BE USED? Feedback gathered through the information sessions, phone, fax and emails will be recorded and summarized in a Consultation Summary Report, which will be submitted to the BC Environmental Assessment Office. The Consultation Summary Report will also be posted on the project website at www.vancouverairportfuel.ca.
