RE: Vancouver Airport Fuel Delivery Project-Neighborhood Stakeholder Update

Further to the project update we provided many of you in early September 2019, please be advised that construction activities will commence on the east side of Highway 99 between Cambie Road and Highway 91 in Richmond in late February 2020, until the end of April 2020. For those not directly adjacent to the aviation fuel pipeline, this may be your first communication with us, however we hope many of you have been aware of this critical infrastructure project from the various media reports over the past few years.

As our goal is to communicate well with all impacted businesses, residents, and commuters, please note the following typical inconveniences and mitigating strategies that accompany these types of projects:

- 1) Additional Noise
 - will be minimized by utilizing sound barriers around large machinery, fencing/tarps, insulated cover material over some generators, and lower impact Hydro-Vac trucks
 - will be in effect Monday to Saturday, 7am to 6pm for 8 or 12 weeks

- 2) Traffic Delays/Detours
 - traffic flagging personnel will be strategically located to minimize vehicle congestion
 - abundant signage will be placed in high visibility locations
 - electronic reader boards will be utilized to keep the public well informed
 - Vanguard Road, south of Cambie Road will experience higher than normal vehicle and equipment traffic
 - Google Maps/Directions will be updated to reflect current traffic patterns

VAFFC is committed in keeping the communication lines open through the construction and operation of this project to ensure stakeholders remain informed about our activities and feel comfortable in contacting us. Based on our current schedule, pipeline construction is projected to be finished in late 2020 with full operations starting in late 2021.

As previously noted, these are projected dates and are subject to change pending permit approvals, equipment deliveries, weather etc. Stakeholders will be kept informed of any major changes to our schedule.
